- **HB 4852 (Cushingberry) – Bill provides for a \$1.35 charge to be added to any technology that accesses 911 for the purposes of creating a public safety fund. The Bureau of Fire Services would receive 6.6% of the total fund.**
- **HB 5036 (Hammel) – Bill to allow for the fees for fire inspection services.**
- **HB 4691-4693 (Schuitmaker) – Fireworks; allows for the expansion of legal fireworks to be sold in Michigan.**
- **HB 4401 (Tobocman) Worker’s compensation; disabilities; occupational cancer; provide presumption for certain firefighters.**
- **SB 102 (Garcia) Worker’s compensation; disabilities; occupational cancer; provide presumption for certain firefighters.**
- **HB 4037 (Lemmons) Labor; public service employment; restriction on residency for employment; repeal.**
- **HB 4118 (Hansen) Police/Fire District Millages. Permits levy of millage assessed for police and fire districts on a per parcel or ad valorem basis.**
- **HB 4365 (Moss) Criminal Procedure; sentencing guidelines; sentencing guidelines for the crime of tampering with, defacing, or stealing of public safety equipment.**
- **HB 4465 (K. Law) Environmental protection; toxic substances or products; release or use of decabromodiphenyl ethers (deca-BDEs); prohibit.**
- **HB 4246 (Opsommer) Intergovernmental affairs; intergovernmental transfer of employees and responsibilities; revise contents of contracts.**
- **HB 4266 (Steil) intergovernmental affairs; intergovernmental transfers of functions and responsibilities; revise contents of contracts.**
- **SB 550 (Garcia) Intergovernmental affairs; intergovernmental transfer of employees and responsibilities; revise contents of contracts.**
- **SB 551 (Garcia) intergovernmental affairs; intergovernmental transfers of functions and responsibilities; revise contents of contracts.**
- **HB 4822 (Byrum) Benefits for surviving spouse and children from an officer who dies in the line of duty.**
- **SB 580 (Garcia) autopsies; fire death autopsies; require, and permit religious objection to autopsies.**
- **HB 4620 (Pavlov) Insurance; no-fault; motor vehicle fire loss reports; expand.**
