  - ii. FCC Regulation change to not allow 911 surcharge money to be used outside of PSAP's. Meaning that the funds cannot be used for things like police car, or other non-dispatch center and infrastructure equipment.
  - iii. Fireworks funds/ Statewide Conference Working through some items with the statewide conference and having it in conjunction with the Expo/ MAFC Conference. Board agreed that the SE Chiefs/ MAFC would maintain the Expo going forward.
  - iv. Midwest Fire Rescue Expo ® in Novi March 2021 is cancelled, looking at April 2022 dates.
  - v. Chief of the Year Nomination letters are being accepted until February 28, 2021. There is currently 1 submission.

- iii. Approved using Fireworks Safety Fees to be used to cover production cost of videos from Subject Matter Experts in Michigan in different chapters to supplement the J & B Curriculum for Fire Officer III, basically TED Talk style videos.
