129th U.P.V.F.A. Firefighter Tournament Race Rules

1. Five Firefighter Ladder Race

- To begin the race, all five racers must be seated on chair with their backs against their seat.
- At the signal from the starter, they may immediately begin dressing into their gear.
- Racers must be completely dressed before crossing the start line.
- Four racers must have a hand on the ladder before it can be advanced.
- Four racers will secure the ladder at a safe angle while the fifth racer will climb the ladder, touching every rung with a hand or foot.
- Time will end when the top rung has been touched.

2. Four Firefighter Dress Relay

- To begin the race, all four racers must be seated on a chair with their backs against their seat.
- At the signal from the starter, both racers will dress completely before crossing the starting line.
- The racers must run down and tag their partner who is seated in an undressed position. The seated partner may not move until tagged by the beginning racer.
- The partners that have been tagged will then dress and run to the starting line.
- The partners must then undress from their gear and take a seat in the starting chair. Time will end once both partners have taken a seat.

3. Five Firefighter Coupling Race

- To begin the race, all five racers must be seated on chair with their backs against their seat.
- At the signal from the starter, they may immediately begin dressing into their gear.
- Racers must be completely dressed before crossing the start line.
- Three lengths of hose will be laid out.
- One racer will connect hose length 1 to the hydrant.
- Another racer will connect hose lengths 1 and 2.
- Another racer will connect hose lengths 2 and 3.
- A fourth racer will connect the nozzle to the end of hose length 3.

- The fifth racer will act as a safetyman with the nozzle man. The safetyman is required to before water is coming out of the nozzle.
- Time will end when the target is moved out of the circle.

4. Five Firefighter Interchange Race

- To begin the race, all five racers must be seated on chair with their backs against their seat.
- At the signal from the starter, they may immediately begin dressing into their gear.
- Racers must be completely dressed before crossing the start line.
- Three lengths of hose will be laid out with the fourth length of hose lying alongside the third hose.
- A racer will connect hose length 1 to the hydrant.
- Another racer will connect hose lengths 1 & 2.
- Another racer will connect hose lengths 2 & 3.
- Another racer will connect the nozzle to the end of hose length 3.
- Another racer will be a safety man at the nozzle before water leaves the nozzle.
- The nozzle racer must push the target out of the circle. At that time, the hose will be clamped off then hose lengths 2 & 3 must be disconnected.
- Hose lengths 2 & 4 must then be attached and hose length 4 must also be attached to the nozzle.
- Once completely reconnected, the nozzle man must move the second target out of the circle. A safety man is required to be at the nozzle with the nozzle man before water comes out.
- Time will end when the second target is moved out of the circle.

5. Mystery Race

• The U.P. Association will approve rules of the Mystery Race Saturday morning after all other races have been completed. Rules of the Mystery Race will be revealed prior to the start of the Mystery Race.

- Start at the intersection of W Genesee St and N 8th Ave.
- March east on W Genesee St
- Finish line will be located near the Klint Safford Memorial RV Park.

Shirttail Parade

Staging Area

• Staging will take place at The Armory (9 W Franklin St)

Route

- Start at The Armory and turn left out of the parking lot.
- Proceed west on W Franklin St
- Turn left onto N 4th Ave. and continue south to W Genesee St
- Turn left onto W Genesee St and continue east
- Finish line will be located on N River Ave.

Commercial Parade

Staging Area

Staging will take place at West Iron High School (700 Washington Ave)

Route

- Start at The West Iron High School and turn left out of the parking lot.
- Proceed north on east on Washington Ave
- Follow the road curving to the left then right and continuing north on Washington Ave.
- Continue north onto Lay Ave
- Turn left onto E Genesee St and continue east
- Finish line will be located on N 8th Ave



Scoring for Dress, Shirt Tail, and Commercial Parade

Parade Participation: Explanation of points scoring

Percent of active members of the department on the tournament roster at the start and finish of the parade will be used to calculate participation. Number of members present is to be taken at the start and finish of the parade. If there is a difference between the number at the start and finish the LOWER number will be used in calculating the percentage.
